H.R. 5852 end GCCI act Ralph Norman (R) S.C.

To prohibit the expenditure of funds to carry out the Global Climate Change Initiative of the United States Agency for International Development, and for other purposes.

S.1756 Rebuild America Now Dan Sullivan(R) Alaska

opens up drilling in Alaska parks Artic National Wildlife refuge

S. 2825 ADAAPT Amend clean air act

By changing” major to minor “in air pollution standards most companies will not be monitored any more after they have one satisfactory pollution release report.

S 2778 Ted Cruz (R) Texas

Amend endangered species act to prohibit a living non native species as endangered (Elephant etc trophy hunting)

S 2761 Rand Paul (R) KY bill to amend the Clean Air Act to clarify when a physical change

U.S. Senator Rand Paul introduced two bills, S. 2760 and S. 2761, to further reduce red tape and burdensome regulations on energy producers by ensuring that power plants are no longer subject to onerous and expensive regulatory processes that discourage efficiencies and improvements. The bills serve as companion legislation to H.R. 3127 and H.R. 3128, which have been introduced in the U.S. House of Representatives by Representative Morgan Griffith (R-VA-9).

H.R. 2522 Eliminate EPA excess Jim Banks (R) Indiana

A survey of excess print and storage supplies (in quantity of copies and weight) held by the Federal storage management facilities of the Environmental Protection Agency and recommendations for recycling and repurposing any printed inventory determined to be in excess, and addressing potential safety hazards associated with excess printed inventory.
